

OPEN CALL “MEMORY PERSON”



Become Part of a Public Art Project dedicated to exile and migration from and to Munich!

Many artists from Munich went into exile, and many artists migrate to Munich today. Become the “Memory Person” to exchange memories and experiences of exile and migration with passers-by in Munich!

The “Memory Person”

- speaks in their native language or any other preferred language.
- wears an interactive outfit designed to exchange stories and belongings with passers-by.
- is enacted by different artists and other interested people

Activities of the “Memory Person”:

- To dwell in specific locations with a connection to Munich’s migration history (e.g. former Agfa Kamerawerk in Giesing, East cemetery)
- To record the wishes of passers-by for their future life in Munich (by sound recording and/or note on parts of the outfit intended for this purpose)
- To collect memories about former residents of Munich who were emigré artists/writers/intellectuals
- In exchange, to spread parts of the outfit intended for this purpose as a give-away to passers-by

Outfit: Light fabrics, logo-like objects attached to the clothes. The logos are text dedications to the state of Being Exiled.

Dates: 28.5., 31.5. + 1.6., 3.6., 4.6., 19.6. 2023

Depending on the weather - some flexibility is needed

Location: Public space in Munich. Exact route will be announced later.

Payment: Fair honorarium individual agreement (approx. 100 Euro/day. Day= approx. 4 hours plus break, drinks and food are provided)
